Communication Questions for Students who are Nonverbal

If a student is nonverbal, ask his parent or caregiver questions to better understand how he communicates. Here's some to get you started!

- 1. How does your child communicate?
- 2. Does he sign? If so, what are three signs we should learn?
- 3. Does he use different types of vocalizations or movements to signify different feelings?
- 4. Does he use gestures to communicate?
- 5. Does he point or nod yes and no when prompted?
- 6. Does he have a communication device? If yes...
 - What kind of support does he need with his device?
 - Does he need help carrying it or turning it on?
 - Does he need prompting?
 - Is he proficient, or is he still learning to use the device?
 - What should we do if the screen locks up? Is there a password?
 - Can we have a quick tutorial?
 - Is there anything else that we should know about his device?
